## Marketing Support Look for the "Kaua'i Made" logo

"Kaua'i Made" will be supported by a marketing program to inform visitors about Kaua'i Made products and drive to point of purchase. Fees are nominal and participants will benefit from enhanced visibility:

- Use of the Kaua'i Made logomark on product packaging and marketing materials
- POP materials for retailers to identify Kaua'i Made products in-store
- Listing in rack brochure product guide—identifying where to shop for Kaua'i Made products
- Full page listing on the Kaua'i Made product web site—to reach visitors before and after their stay ([www.kauaimade.net](http://www.kauaimade.net))
- Other opportunities as they become available

## Who can Participate?

The Kaua'i Made program invites applications for products that are made on island, by Kaua'i-based businesses and individuals using Kaua'i materials. We also encourage these retailers who sell these products to apply.

A wide range of categories are welcome, such as food, beauty, crafts, apparel, music, art jewelry, gifts and others. All applications will be reviewed to ensure that all participants meet the criteria and deliver a quality product experience.

## How to Apply

Both vendors and retailers of Kaua'i Made products are invited to apply. Please provide access to the following documentation to complete the application process:

- General Excise Tax License
- Tax Clearance Form
- Certificate of Good Standing
- For vendors only—product sample and/or photograph of product line
- For retailers only—photograph of retail space and Kaua'i Products section, if one exists
- For agricultural and some health and beauty products, documentation of Department of Health or other certifications may be required
